MESSAGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE

M. "00" INFO

(N)

1. General

"00" INFO is an information or directory service where Customers may obtain information for locations within the United States such as telephone numbers and area codes (NPAs), as well as international country and/or city codes and time-of-day information. Customers may access this service by dialing "00" and selecting Prompt 1, by dialing 1-800-CALLATT and selecting Prompt 4, or by dialing other such access numbers as may be designated by the Company. Up to 12 requests for listings may be made on each call to "00" INFO. Customers will be billed a "00" INFO charge for each two intrastate listings requested or portion thereof. The "00" INFO charge applies when AT&T undertakes a search for the requested information whether or not AT&T furnishes the requested information. Charges for "00" INFO may be billed to the calling station or to a consumer calling card. Calls placed via 1-800-CALLATT may only be billed to a consumer calling card.

The following types of calls are not permitted to "00" INFO:

- Person-to-Person calls
- Collect calls
- Calls billed to a third number
- Calls billed to a Commercial Charge/Credit Card
- Calls made via USADirect
- Coin calls
- Certain sent paid calls from hotels, hospitals, dormitories, and coin telephones where calls may be blocked or billing capability does not exist.

"00" INFO calls made on a line which the subscriber pays a rate that is described solely as a business or commercial rate in the applicable local exchange service tariff for switched services or charged to a Commercial Calling Card are included in AT&T Commercial Long Distance Service. This service is available where billing capability permits.
