ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On various dates during this proceeding, the attorney examiner and the Commission granted confidential treatment to certain portions of the record.
- (2) On May 22, 1998, Ameritech Ohio (Ameritech) filed a motion for a protective order continuing the confidential treatment of certain evidence. In its motion, Ameritech states that, in this proceeding, certain portions of the record were granted confidential treatment by the attorney examiner and the Commission. Ameritech further states that it has begun, but has not completed, the process of evaluating the extent to which documents previously granted protection continue to require such treatment. As a result, Ameritech requests that all of the confidential submissions in this proceeding remain redacted from the public record until Ameritech has completed its review and submitted a supplemental memorandum detailing the need for continued protection from disclosure of specific portions of those submissions. Ameritech states that it will submit its supplemental memorandum by June 22, 1998.
- (3) On May 27, 1998, AT&T Communications of Ohio, Inc. (AT&T) filed a response to Ameritech's renewed motion for protective order. AT&T states that it does not object to Ameritech's request that all of the confidential submissions in this proceeding remain redacted from the public record and protected from disclosure until a further review of those documents and record has occurred. AT&T states further that it has discussed with Ameritech the possibility of submitting a joint supplemental memorandum once such a review has occurred and it has committed to work towards filing such supplemental memorandum in support on or before June 22, 1998.

- (4) Upon review, the attorney examiner finds that there is good cause to grant Ameritech a limited amount of time to complete its requested review. Accordingly, Ameritech's request for continued confidential treatment should be granted and all materials deemed confidential should remain in that status until such time as the attorney examiner or the Commission deems otherwise. Further, the attorney examiner expects that Ameritech will submit on or before June 22, 1998, its supplemental memorandum.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That all evidence deemed confidential should remain so treated by the Commission until otherwise noted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry should be served upon AT&T, Ameritech, and their respective counsel, and all other parties of record.
