On July 17, 2006, tariff pages for the Ameritech Operating Companies were filed with the Federal Communications Commission under Transmittal No. 1564. This filing in the FCC No. 2 Tariff became effective on August 1, 2006.

The filing was made by SBC to increase the End User Common Line and Universal Service Fund charges to cover additional costs associated with Number Portability. Charges previously collected via the End User Common Line rate were insufficient to AT&T costs. These charges are being recovered pursuant to the FCC Order released July 10, 2006.

- Assess an exogenous cost change adjustment to the End User Common Line (EUCL) rates, and
- Revise the Universal Service Fund (USF) recovery charges billed to residential and business customers to reflect the increase in EUCL rates.

This exogenous cost adjustment filing is being made pursuant to In the Matter of Petition of AT&T Inc. for Waiver of the Commission's Rules to Treat Certain Local Number Portability Costs as Exogenous Cost Under Section 61.45(d), Order, FCC 06-97 (CC Docket No. 95-116), released July 10, 2006.
