ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On April 12, 2005, Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. and Cox Newspapers, Inc. (complainants) filed a complaint alleging, among other things, that The Cincinnati Gas and Electric Company (CG&E) charged complainants and 23 other Constellation NewEnergy customers for service at rates other than what was approved by the Commission.
- (2) On May 3, 2005, CG&E filed an answer admitting, in part, and denying, in part, the allegations of the complaint.
- (3) On June 7, 2005, a settlement conference was held at the offices of the Commission to determine whether this matter can be resolved informally. While no settlement was reached, the parties determined that it would be appropriate to discuss the matter further, at a second conference.
- (4) The attorney examiner therefore concludes that a telephonic settlement conference should be held on June 21, 2005, at 10:00 a.m. At that time, parties should call the Commission's bridge line at 614-644-1080.


It is, therefore,


