ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Rule 4901:5-3-01(A), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.) requires each electric distribution utility and electric transmission owner to file annually a long-term forecast report on or before April fifteenth of each year. Further, Rule 4901:5-3-01(D) states that the Commission may grant an extension of the filing deadline for good cause shown.
- (2) On May 3, 2005, Monongahela Power Company (Mon Power) filed a motion to extend the deadline to file its long-term forecast report to May 20, 2005.
- (3) Mon Power's motion should be granted. Mon Power shall file its long-term forecast report by May 20, 2005.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Mon Power's motion for extension of time to file its long-term forecast report be granted. Mon Power shall file its long-term forecast report by May 20, 2005. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


