intervention of that body in the dispute. If the customer does file a complaint with the Commission, all action to disconnect his service will be withheld until the dispute can be adjudicated by the Commission.

- f. With respect to restoration of service and/or reestablishment of credit upon a service disconnection, the customer will be required to meet those conditions outlined in the Tariff Section governing advance payments and deposits as set forth in Section 2.33.
- g. The Telephone Company may disconnect the toll service of a customer who fails to pay charges for toll service provided by the Telephone Company or by interexchange carriers (IXC's) for which the Telephone Company provides billing and collection services and from which the Telephone Company purchases the associated accounts receivable in advance.
- h. Disconnection of a customer's toll service for nonpayment of toll charges shall be made in accordance with the rules as specified in this section, as well as the Minimum Telephone Service Standards contained in the Ohio Administrative Code of Rules and Regulations.
- i. The Telephone Company will apportion partial payments to regulated local service charges before applying them to toll charges.
- j. The Telephone Company shall respond promptly to customer inquiries pertaining to charges for toll services, either by handling the inquiry itself, or referring it to the IXC, depending on the nature of the customer's inquiry.
- k. Disconnection of a customer's toll service for nonpayment of toll charges shall be accomplished through universal toll blocking, offered to all toll service providers on a nondiscriminatory basis. Toll disconnection service shall be provided as follows: (T)
