ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 6, 1997, the Commission issued an Opinion and Order which, subject to revisions, approved the interconnection agreement entered into by Ameritech Ohio (Ameritech) and Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint).
- (2) On April 7, 1997, Sprint filed an application for rehearing on the issue of the appropriate rates for the resale of short-term promotional offerings of less than 90 days. Sprint argued that the Commission's decision lacks record support and was unreasonable and/or unlawful.
- (3) On April 14, 1997, Ameritech filed a memorandum contra Sprint's application for rehearing. Ameritech characterizes Sprint's pleading as an improper collateral attack on the Commission's local service guidelines issued in Case No. 95-845-TP-COI.
- (4) On April 18, 1997, Sprint filed a motion to withdraw its application for rehearing. Sprint explains that other matters have arisen which preclude it from pursuing its appeal.
- (5) The Commission finds that Sprint's motion to withdraw its application for rehearing is reasonable and should be granted.





