



electric service providers. No party filed a response in opposition to Duke's motion for an extension of the protective order.


- (3) The attorney examiner finds that Duke's motion for an extension of the protective order should be granted. Therefore, the Commission's docketing division should maintain under seal the information ordered held confidential by the May 13, 2004 entry in this docket, for 18 months from the date of this entry, after which the protective order will automatically expire, in accordance with Rule 4901-1-24(F), Ohio Administrative Code. Extensions of the protective order may be requested by filing an appropriate motion at least 45 days in advance of the expiration of the existing order.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That for a period of 18 months from the date of this entry, the Docketing Division shall maintain under seal the information ordered held confidential by our May 13, 2004 entry in this docket. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon interested persons of record.
