

Dear Ms. Jenkins,

Cleveland Unlimited, Inc. (dba Revol) requires an additional NXX in the Toledo LATA, LATA 326, for the purpose of establishing new Location Routing Number (LRNs) for tandem homing arrangements of its switch. Revol will be taking ownership of the Cricket Communications wireless license in Toledo and will need to test all LEC and Revol call routing translations prior to cutover of the Toledo subscribers to the Revol switching system (located in Cleveland).

Since Revol is unable to test these translations with the existing Cricket LRN and associated NXX's we would need the new LRN and NXX at least three weeks in advance of the network conversion (June 30, 2006). An in-service date for the new LRN and NXX of June 9, 2006 would be enough time to ensure a pre-tested, trouble free network cutover for the Toledo customer base.

**AMENDMENT TO
CELLULAR/PCS INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

by and between

NORTHCOAST COMMUNICATIONS, L.L.C.

and

THE OHIO BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY

This Amendment is entered into by and between The Ohio Bell Telephone Company d/b/a SBC Ohio ("Telco") and Cleveland Unlimited, Inc., formerly known as Northcoast Communications, LLC ("Carrier") and shall serve to amend the Cellular/PCS Interconnection Agreement by and between The Ohio Bell Telephone Company and Northcoast Communications, L.L.C. dated June 6, 2001 ("The Interconnection Agreement").

WHEREAS, Telco and Carrier entered into The Interconnection Agreement dated June 6, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Carrier changed its name to "Cleveland Unlimited, Inc.", and wishes to reflect that name change as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, Carrier notified Telco on October 13, 2004, of certain State-specific, Carrier-specific InterMTA Traffic Information on which it based a request under Paragraph 11.3.2 of The Interconnection Agreement for a reduction in the percentage of Carrier-to-Telco traffic delivered by Carrier to Telco that is deemed InterMTA traffic; and

WHEREAS, Carrier and Telco have negotiated a mutually acceptable change to the percentage of Carrier-to-Telco traffic delivered by Carrier to Telco that is deemed InterMTA traffic;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend The Interconnection Agreement as follows:

1. The Interconnection Agreement is hereby amended to reflect the name change of Northcoast Communications, LLC to "Cleveland Unlimited, Inc."
2. Telco shall reflect that name change from "Northcoast Communications, LLC" to "Cleveland Unlimited, Inc." only for the main billing account (header card) for each of the accounts previously billed to Carrier. Telco shall not be obligated, whether under this Amendment or otherwise, to make any other changes to Telco's records with respect to those accounts, including to the services and items provided and/or billed thereunder or under The Interconnection Agreement. Without limiting the foregoing, Carrier affirms, represents, and warrants that the OCN for those accounts shall not change from that previously used by Carrier with Telco for those accounts and the services and items provided and/or billed thereunder or under The Interconnection Agreement.
3. Once this Amendment is effective, Carrier shall operate with Telco under the "Cleveland Unlimited, Inc." name for those accounts. Such operation shall include, by way of example

only, submitting orders under Cleveland Unlimited, and labeling (including re-labeling) equipment and facilities with Cleveland Unlimited.

4. Carrier represents and warrants that it has no roaming traffic, that it receives no traffic from interexchange carriers that is then forwarded by Carrier to Telco, and that Carrier's cellular/PCS system is entirely contained within one MTA, that being MTA #016. Based on the foregoing representations and warranties, Carrier asserts that it delivers no interMTA traffic (as that term is defined in The Interconnection Agreement) to Telco.
5. Based on the representations and warranties contained in paragraph 4 above, the Parties agree that the percentage of Carrier-to-Telco traffic delivered by Carrier to Telco through the Trunks provided for in The Interconnection Agreement that is deemed InterMTA traffic in Section 11.3.2 of The Interconnection Agreement shall be zero percent (0.0%) effective as of October 13, 2004.
6. The changes contained in this Amendment (or any of them individually) will not apply to other carriers who may adopt this Agreement unless similar carrier-specific information is provided and that carrier's situation as to a particular change is substantially similar to Carrier's situation.
7. All other terms and conditions of The Interconnection Agreement remain unchanged.
8. This Amendment shall not modify or extend the Effective Date or Term of The Interconnection Agreement, but rather, shall be coterminous with such agreement.
9. Except as modified herein, all other terms and conditions of The Interconnection Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

If any action by any state or federal regulatory or legislative body or court of competent jurisdiction invalidates, modifies, or stays the enforcement of laws or regulations that were the basis or rationale for any rate(s), term(s) and/or condition(s) ("Provisions") of The Interconnection Agreement and this Amendment and/or otherwise affects the rights or obligations of either Party that are addressed by The Interconnection Agreement and this Amendment, specifically including but not limited to those arising with respect to the Government Actions, the affected Provision(s) shall be immediately invalidated, modified or stayed consistent with the action of the regulatory or legislative body or court of competent jurisdiction upon the written request of either Party ("Written Notice"). With respect to any Written Notices hereunder, the Parties shall have sixty (60) days from the Written Notice to attempt to negotiate and arrive at an agreement on the appropriate conforming modifications to The Interconnection Agreement. If the Parties are unable to agree upon the conforming modifications required within sixty (60) days from the Written Notice, any disputes between the Parties concerning the interpretation of the actions required or the provisions affected by such order shall be resolved pursuant to the dispute resolution process provided for in The Interconnection Agreement.

11. This Amendment shall be filed with and subject to approval by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.
