The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On December 30, 1999, Columbus Southern Power Company and Ohio Power Company (jointly referred to as "AEP") filed applications for approval of their transition plans and for receipt of transition revenues. Those applications were docketed as Case Nos. 99-1729-EL-ETP and 99-1730-EL-ETP.
- (2) On April 28, 2000, a second prehearing conference was held in these matters. During follow-up discussions between AEP and a number of the parties in these proceedings that same day, parties requested that the filing deadline for intervenor testimony be extended in order to allow parties to concentrate upon settlement efforts. The examiner orally agreed to the requested extension.
- (3) This entry will formalize the examiner's agreement to extend the deadline for the intervenors to prefile expert testimony in these proceedings. Intervenor testimony shall now be filed no later 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 5, 2000. Additionally, copies of such prefiled expert testimony should be delivered to both examiners.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the filing deadline for intervenor expert testimony is extended until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 5, 2000. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


