Enclosed for filing is the Application of United Telephone Company of Ohio d/b/a Sprint to make certain revisions to its Local Exchange Tariff, P.U.C.O. No. 6. With this filing, Sprint is proposing to reclassify its PBX trunk as a flexibly priced service specifically for the exchange of Mason.

The reclassification is being filed in accordance with the Opinion and Order in Case No. 84-944-TP-COI, which allows a Local Exchange Carrier to file flexible rate schedules for a service offering deemed to be competitive. Minimum and maximum rates are established as allowed in case no. 84-944-TP-COI and reaffirmed in Case No. 86-1144-TP-COI with the maximum rate being no more than two times the minimum rate level.

In addition to the above, 95-845-TP-COI, In the Matter of the Commission's Investigation Relative to the Establishment of Local Exchange Competition and Other Competitive Issues, VI.H. allows for geographical market based deaveraging by customer type or class. Sprint submits that this application is in the public interest and will allow Sprint to respond more efficiently to prevailing market prices in the Mason exchange. (Refer to C-2, page 2 of 2 for additional information and support of the competitive nature of this service.)

This tariff filing will not result in an increase in the PBX trunk rate for the Mason exchange. The rate will remain at \$108.65 for the present time, which is the current Flat Rate Service rate for a PBX trunk for customers in Schedule IX.

United Telephone Company of Ohio d/b/a Sprint Memorandum in Support of a Finding Exchange Specific, PBX Trunk Rate As a Competitive Service

In accordance with the Commission's 1985 Opinion and Order in Case No. 84-944-TP-COI, United Telephone Company of Ohio d/b/a Sprint submits this memorandum with respect to the competitive nature of its existing Trunk Service and the public benefits that result from the reclassification.

As indicated in the application, Sprint proposes to reclassify its existing PBX Trunk rate as a competitive service offering for the Mason exchange only. The presence of Time Warner Telecom of Ohio, L.P. (Time Warner) and Cincinnati Bell Long Distance Inc. (CBLD) requires a competitive response for customers in the Mason exchange. These competitors are currently providing service via facility based company.

As indicated in the application, Sprint proposes to reclassify its existing PBX Trunk rate as a competitive service offering for the Mason exchange only. The presence of Time Warner and CBLD requires a competitive response for customers in the Mason exchange. These competitors are currently providing service via facility based company. (Refer to Attachment 1 and 2 for Time Warner and CBLD tariffs.) Since they are competitors, Sprint does not have access to the number of accounts they have secured in Mason. Sprint can however provide an example of accounts that have changed to competitors for PBX trunks:

Martin-Marieta was lost to Time Warner Intergraph Corporation was lost to CBLD

The following accounts have expressed that they are looking at other competitors for PBX trunks:

Entex Information Services GE Capital Kings Island

While Sprint could just request a rate decrease for the Mason PBX trunks, such a change would not allow for efficient response to competitive pressures in the future. Flexible pricing is required in order to change rates to meet current market conditions in Mason.

Deaveraging the rates for Mason PBX trunks is in the public interest and will permit Sprint to continue to compete for this business. Absent flexible pricing for this service Sprint will continue to lose customers to the competitive local exchange carriers without the ability to effectively compete in the market.
