NOW COMES BFI COMMUNICATION, INC. ("Applicant") by and through its attorneys, EARLY, LENNON, PETERS & CROCKER, P.C., and petitions this honorable Commission to enter an order providing that this Applicant is not a regulated entity subject to the Commission's jurisdiction and accordingly will not be required to apply for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a reseller of telecommunications service in the State of Ohio prior to commencing service. In accordance with the foregoing, this Applicant provides as follows:

C. This Applicant is a privately-held corporation organized under the laws of the State of California. A copy of this Applicant's Articles of Incorporation is attached as Exhibit A. This Applicant is authorized to transact business as a foreign corporation within the State of Ohio. A copy of the qualifying document is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

D. This Applicant will not engage in the switching and processing of telephone calls or transmit telephone messages to the public within the State of Ohio as defined in Sections 4905.02 and 4905.03, Revised Code. Accordingly, this Applicant avers that it is not a telephone company or a public utility subject to Commission jurisdiction pursuant to Case Number 84-944-TP-COI (84-944), Opinion and Order issued April 9, 1985. Moreover, in accordance with the Order issued by the Commission in Case No. 89-563-TP-ACE, this Applicant provides the following information in support of this Petition:

1. This Applicant seeks to provide the resale of intrastate interexchange telecommunications services throughout the State of Ohio. This Applicant proposes to offer a full range of 1+ interexchange telecommunications services. Specifically, this Applicant will offer 1+, Dedicated Outbound, Switched Outbound, and Calling Card services.
2. This Applicant proposes to resell telecommunications services to business and residential customers.
3. This Applicant intends to provide this service as a non-facilities based reseller and does not own any equipment relating to the transmitting of the proposed telecommunications services. In addition, this Applicant will not

construct any new facilities in Ohio to provide the services as contemplated herein.

4. This Applicant will not provide least cost routing to customers in the State of Ohio.
5. This Applicant will not add additional calling features to the message toll service purchased from its underlying carrier.
6. This Applicant does not provide or bill for operator services or directory assistance. This Applicant will provide or bill for Calling Cards. This Applicant establishes the rates for Calling Card services.
7. This Applicant offers services to the public, utilizing the underlying network facilities arranged by GTE.
8. This Applicant's underlying carrier knows the name and location of this Applicant's customers.
9. This Applicant establishes the prices to be charged to customers.
10. This Applicant's customers in Ohio will originate 1+ calls over local exchange company ("LEC") access lines. The LEC central office will switch calls to BFIC's underlying carrier's point of presence within Ohio. The carrier will then terminate the calls over its termination facilities. A diagram describing the foregoing is attached as Exhibit C.
11. This Applicant's underlying facilities based carrier in Ohio views BFIC as its subscriber or customer of record. This Applicant purchases services from GTE pursuant to a contract.
12. This Applicant's end users are customers of this Applicant and not the

underlying facilities based carrier. The customers contract with this Applicant.

13. Applicant provides a sample contracts for business and residential customers as Exhibit D. This Applicant will verify and confirm all orders to change long distance service in accordance with 47 C.F.R., Subpart K - Changing Long Distance Service, Section 64.1100, and will comply with all Commission rules and orders pertaining to same.
14. The underlying carrier will invoice this Applicant monthly for services rendered.
15. The underlying carrier provides network services for customer calls.
16. The underlying carrier will provide this Applicant with magnetic call detail tapes containing the necessary data for this Applicant to bill end users. U.S.B.I. will perform billing functions for this Applicant. A copy of a sample bill will be provided upon request.
17. This Applicant recognizes that as an unregulated entity, it cannot terminate the local services of its end users for non-payment of long distance services pursuant to Chapter 4901: 1-5, Ohio Administrative Code.
18. This Applicant will disconnect an end user's interexchange service for nonpayment. However, this Applicant will provide such customers with notice in accordance with the Rules and Orders of the Commission prior to such disconnection.
19. The end user's interexchange carrier of choice will provide service to end users upon disconnection for this Applicant's services.

-
20. This Applicant's underlying carrier will serve as the primary interexchange carrier on equal access ballots.
 21. This Applicant is responsible for resolving all complaints that an end user may have with this Applicant's services. This Applicant provides all end users with the following toll-free number to report complaints or service problems: (800) 771-1334.
 22. End users may incur a charge on their LEC bill should this Applicant change underlying carriers. Notwithstanding, this Applicant will reimburse end users for all such charges.
 23. This Applicant will provide Customers with a package which will include language that comports with the Commission Finding and Order of July 9, 1992.
 24. This Applicant will not rely upon non-profit organizations to perform marketing activities. However, this Applicant may market services through unaffiliated distributors. This Applicant will appear as the entity providing telecommunications services in all literature, and will provide billing and customer service to such end users, subject to the foregoing averments.

WHEREFORE, BFI COMMUNICATION, INC. respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Ohio issue an Order providing that it does not regulate the services contemplated herein by this Applicant.

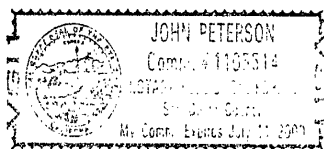
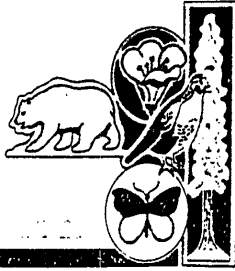

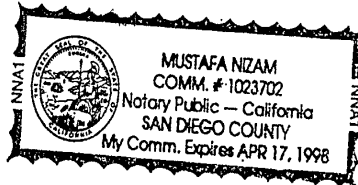

3. The application must be signed by the president, vice-president, secretary or treasurer of the corporation and must be notarized. (O.R.C. 1703.041)

In item 6, the agent for service of process may be (a) a natural person who is a resident of Ohio, or (b) an Ohio corporation or a foreign corporation licensed in Ohio which is explicitly authorized by its articles to act as statutory agent and which has a business address in Ohio. (O.R.C. 1703.041)
5. No foreign corporation which previously should have obtained a license to do business in Ohio shall maintain any action in any court until it has obtained such a license.
