Dear Ms. Crockron:

Yesterday, Winstar Wireless, Inc. ("Old Winstar") and Winstar Communications, LLC ("New Winstar") filed certain information in response to Commission Staff Member Jay Agranoff's request for information. As indicated in that filing, certain data had to be supplemented as the information was not readily available. The supplemental information pertains only to question one of Mr. Agranoff's inquiries.

1. What is the number of access lines affected by the Cleveland and Columbus withdrawal of service?

**There are 592 access lines serving the 303 affected business customers in Cleveland and Columbus.**


In a telephone conversation with Mr. Agranoff earlier today, Mr. Agranoff indicated that he would probably have to remove the application from automatic approval and, instead, have the Commission issue an order. Old Winstar and New Winstar repeat that they remain committed to working with Commission Staff in any way possible to keep the automatic approval on track for Friday, March 22. However, if this is impossible, New Winstar respectfully emphasizes that it still needs approval from the Commission no later than April 2, 2002 for the discontinuance so that the equipment and facilities serving these customers can be decommissioned by April 17, 2002.
