## **ENTRY**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 31, 2000, Nancy Bloom filed a complaint against the Ohio Edison Company (hereinafter respondent) alleging that respondent provided inadequate service due to excessive billing.
- (2) On May 31, 2000, the Commission served respondent with a copy of the complaint and directed the company to file its answer and any other responsive pleadings within 20 days. On April 20, 2000, respondent filed its answer along with a motion to dismiss the complaint.
- (3) On July 21, 2000, a prehearing settlement conference was conducted. Following the June 21, 2000, prehearing conference, counsel for respondent reported that the parties came to an acceptable agreement, and that respondent would file a motion to dismiss the case once complainant returned a signed release form.
- (4) On October 1, 2001, respondent filed a motion to dismiss without prejudice.
- (5) Rule 4901-9-01(D), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that a complaint may be dismissed when a case has been settled, if complainant fails to file within 15 days a memorandum contra the respondent's motion to dismiss.
- (6) The complainant and respondent reached a settlement agreement at the prehearing settlement conference. The complainant has failed to file a memorandum contra respondent's motion to dismiss. Therefore, the Commission will dismiss the complaint without prejudice.

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It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case No. 00-606-EL-CSS be dismissed without prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
