New language will be added to Section 5 (Ordering Options for Switched and Special Access Service) of F.C.C. No. 2. Existing SNA language found in the product specific sections of the tariff will be grandfathered, and customers will be referred back to the new SNA language in Section 5. The SNA Processing Charge will remain the same. New definitions, pertaining to SNA, will be added to the tariff.
