ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Columbus Southern Power Company (Columbus Southern) and Licking Rural Electrification, Inc. (Licking) are electric suppliers as defined in Section 4933.81, Revised Code.
- (2) Certification by the Commission of the territories of Columbus Southern and Licking was approved by Entries dated June 3, 1981 and June 3, 1981 in Case No. 78-1311-EL-ORD.
- (3) Columbus Southern and Licking have jointly petitioned the Commission to reallocate their service territories in Harrison Township, Licking County, Ohio. Specifically, they request the following relocation:

On quadrangle map N18-Jersey, relocate the existing boundary line beginning at a point of intersection between the existing boundary line and the east border of Hazelwood Subdivision. Proceed south approximately 20 feet then due west approximately 301 feet (between lots 202 and 203, Section 4, Part 1), to the centerline of Kelci Jayne Drive, thence due northwest to the intersection of Kelci Jayne Drive and Brentwood and Cranberry Drives, thence follow Brentwood Drive to its intersection with Corylus Drive, thence proceeding north on Corylus Drive to its intersection with Keela Drive, thence west approximately 630 feet until Keela Drive intersects with the current boundary line.

- (4) In support of their request, the petitioners state that certain roads within this subdivision present a more clearly defined boundary line than does the existing straight boundary line, which segments many of the subdivision's lots. The proposed boundary line minimizes the occurrences of adjacent homes being served by differing utilities.
- (5) Section 4933.83 (E), Revised Code, provides in pertinent part:

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Notwithstanding the effectuation of certified territories established by or pursuant to Sections 4933.81 to 4933.90 of the Revised Code, and the exclusive right of electric suppliers to serve within such territory, and notwithstanding any other provisions of such sections establishing rights of electric suppliers to furnish electric service, any two or more electric suppliers may jointly petition the Commission for the reallocation of their own territories and electric load centers among them and designating which portions of such territories and electric load centers are to be served by each of the electric suppliers.

- (6) No exception to the change described in Finding (3) has been brought to the Commission's attention.
- (7) The Commission finds that granting the requested relief will promote the purposes of Sections 4933.81 to 4933.90, Revised Code, and will further promote the provision of adequate service to all territories and electric load centers affected by the relocation. Accordingly, the Commission shall order the appropriate modification of the territorial boundary of Columbus Southern and Licking.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the request of Columbus Southern and Licking to relocate their territory boundary is granted. It is, further,


ORDERED, That the change on quadrangle map N18-Jersey, described in Finding (3), be approved to show the boundary line change. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.


