ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 22, 2005, Norfolk Southern Railway Co. (NS) filed a request to modify the warning devices at the County Road 16 grade crossing (477-500S), located in Montpelier, Williams County. In its request, NS indicated that it is constructing new track through the crossing and it seeks to relocate the existing grade crossing protection equipment and install new detection equipment for the new track.
- (2) The attorney examiner directs NS to file with the Commission a detailed explanation of its proposed modification, site plans for the proposed modification, and an estimate of the duration of the project. These documents should be filed by February 13, 2006. NS should serve a copy of these documents on Madison Township, which serves as the local highway authority for this crossing.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds it appropriate that Madison Township be permitted the opportunity to file comments on NS's request. Therefore, Madison Township should file with the Commission any comments by February 20, 2006. All such comments should reference the case number of this proceeding (Case No. 05-1576-RR-RCP).
- (4) The attorney examiner also directs Commission staff to file a response to NS's request by February 28, 2006.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, by February 13, 2006, NS file a detailed explanation of its proposed modification, site plans, and an estimate of the duration of the project. It is, further,


