

FoxTel, Inc.
Description of Services

FoxTel, Inc. ("FoxTel") proposes to offer operator assisted service to time share resorts throughout the State of Ohio.

Operator Assisted Service

FoxTel's operator services allow customers to place local, intraLATA and interLATA calls with the assistance of a live or automated operator. Each operator assisted call is routed over the company's underlying carrier's network to the company's switching facility and operator center for credit validation, billing data collection and/or dialing assistance. The call is completed by a FoxTel operator (live or automated) over the resold transmission facilities of an underlying interexchange carrier once the call has been processed.

All operator assisted calls handled by FoxTel are branded with FoxTel's name and billed at rates as specified in its tariffs. Informational stickers are provided by the company for placement by or on each telephone which identifies FoxTel as the operator service provider and includes a toll-free contact number for rate information.

A number of billing alternatives are available with FoxTel's service. The end user may be billed by a local exchange company or by a commercial credit card company, depending upon the payment method selected by the end user. Billing options available through a local exchange company include billing to a valid telephone company issued calling card, collect to the called party, or to an acceptable third party telephone number.
