ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On April 5, 1996, in accordance with the Commission's Opinion and Order of March 21, 1996, in Case No. 96-66-TP-CSS (Case No. 96-66), Ameritech filed tariffs in Case Nos. 96-66, 96-347-TP-ATA, and 90-5032-TP-TRF.
- (2) Pursuant to the Attorney Examiner Entry of April 12, 1996, in Case 96-66, Ameritech, on April 17, 1996, withdrew the docketed tariff sheets from the aforementioned cases and instead, submitted them to staff for its review. The Entry informed Ameritech that the tariffs were to be limited to the previous Commission directives related to compensation for the termination of traffic, interim number portability, and interexchange carrier access revenue allocation.
- (3) On April 22, 1996, Time Warner submitted its objections to staff regarding the Ameritech tariffs.
- (4) Ameritech is now directed to refile its proposed tariffs in this case by May 15, 1996. Objections to the tariff filing must be filed and served upon Ameritech by May 22, 1996. Ameritech shall have until May 28, 1996, to file its reply and to serve it upon the all persons who file objections.

Ameritech is reminded that its proposed tariffs should be in accordance with the directives stated in the Commission's Opinion and Order of March 21, 1996, and the Attorney Examiner Entry of April 12, 1996, as well as the informal recommendations provided by staff. All proposed tariff language not specifically addressing the Commission's intent of such tariffs should be deleted.

The docketed proposed tariff sheets should not be Time Warner specific but rather, should reflect services available to all potential customers. In accordance with the Commission's Opinion and Order of March 21, 1996, in Case

No. 96-66, the tariff sheets ultimately approved by the Commission shall be interim in nature and will sunset on December 31, 1997. Prior to that time, the Commission will determine whether the replacement tariffs will be based on the findings of the Commission's generic local competition docket and/or an Ameritech specific proceeding

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Ameritech docket its proposed tariff sheets in accordance with this Entry, on or before May 15, 1996. It is, further,

ORDERED, That all interested entities and Ameritech file their respective objections and reply in accordance with this Entry. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon the parties and all interested persons of record.
