The Attorney Examiner, pursuant to the authority granted by Rule 4901-1-14, Ohio Administrative Code, finds:


- (1) On April 13, 1996, the application of Atmuri Telecom, Inc. (Atmuri), filed in this case, was suspended in order to allow further investigation and to allow Atmuri additional time to submit information to complete its application.
- (2) After repeated requests by the staff and the attorney examiner, Atmuri has failed to submit the requisite information. Accordingly, Atmuri must file with the Commission, on or before January 17, 1997, evidence that it is licensed to do business in Ohio and a copy of all contracts between Atmuri and the underlying carriers it plans to do business. Failure to timely file this information may result in the dismissal of this application.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Atmuri file by January 17, 1997, the information required by Finding (2). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon the applicant and all interested persons of record.


