- (1) Commission staff has served a notice of preliminary determination upon P&D Transportation, Inc. (respondent) in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging violations of the Commission's Transportation Safety Rules.
- (2) On October 25, 2002, respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) As set forth in Rule 4901:2-7-16(B), O.A.C., unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be conducted within 30 days of the filing of a request for administrative hearing.
- (4) Because the Commission desired to further review matters associated with civil forfeiture cases, the prehearing conference for this case was postponed until a date to be scheduled by entry.
- (5) The parties in this case are directed to participate in a prehearing teleconference on December 17, 2002, at 10:00 a.m. At that time, Commission staff will attempt to contact respondent by telephone.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a prehearing teleconference in this case be scheduled in accordance with Finding (5). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
