Request for Extension of Time To File Report Pursuant to 4901:1-10-26, Ohio Administrative Code

Comes Now Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company ("FirstEnergy Companies"), by counsel, and hereby request an extension of time to file their report pursuant to 4901:1-10-26, Ohio Administrative Code, ("ESSS Rule 26") which is otherwise due to be filed on March 31, 2005.

Pursuant to 4901:1-10-02(C), the Commission may waive any requirement of Chapter 4901-10 for good cause shown or upon its own motion. The FirstEnergy Companies state that good cause has been shown for the requested extension, as is more fully set forth below.

In support of this request for extension, the FirstEnergy Companies state that while this year's Rule 26 report is required to be filed in a traditional paper format, the data is also required to be entered into data sets in XML format. Additional time is needed to input such data and meet with the Staff to confirm that such data has been entered properly and completely, and in a manner consistent with the traditional paper submission, in order to avoid the necessity for corrective filings to be subsequently made in this docket. Further, the coincidence of the Easter holiday period and the due date for this and other annual reporting requirements has resulted in key personnel not being available prior to the current due date for final review prior to filing.

Therefore, the FirstEnergy Companies submit that the requested brief extension in the filing of the Rule 26 Report will not prejudice any party request that the date to file this report be extended to and including Friday April 29, 2005.

In conclusion, FirstEnergy requests the filing date for the ESSS Rule 26 report be extended to and including April 29, 2005, and for all other relief just and proper in the premise.
