On September 5, 2006, tariff pages for the Ameritech Operating Companies were filed with the Federal Communications Commission under Transmittal No. 1573. This filing in the FCC No. 2 Tariff became effective on September 6, 2006.

The filing was made by SBC to enhance the OPT-E-MAN Service Level Agreements to provide a more robust service agreement. This filing also adds Customized Switched Metro Ethernet (CSME) to the OPT-E-MAN product, introduces the OPT-E-MAN product to several new LATAs, and waives certain non-recurring charges.



With this filing, Ameritech is proposing to enhance OPT-E-MAN[®] Service Level Agreements (SLAs) to provide a more robust service guarantee. Existing customers with OPT-E-MAN[®] SLAs will automatically receive the higher service guarantee. These proposed updates do not represent any diminution of the existing OPT-E-MAN[®] service. Ameritech is also proposing to add Customized Switched Metro Ethernet (CSME) service, a best effort grade of service, to the OPT-E-MAN[®] product. In addition, Ameritech is proposing to introduce OPT-E-MAN[®] service in several new LATAs, waive certain non-recurring charges, delete obsolete verbiage and upgrade the service mark associated with OPT-E-MAN[®] to a registered trademark.
