The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 13, 2003, Champaign Family YMCA (YMCA) filed a complaint alleging that Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia) overcharged the YMCA for natural gas service.
- (2) Subsequently, Columbia filed a motion to dismiss the complaint stating that the parties have resolved their differences by settlement agreement. Columbia stated that, since nothing more remains to be done, the complaint should be dismissed as a settled case.
- (3) Rule 4901-9-01(E), Ohio' Administrative Code, provides that, if the public utility complained against files a motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response to Columbia's motion has been filed. Accordingly, Columbia's motion to dismiss should be granted and this case should be closed of record.
