ENTRY NUNC PRO TUNC

The Commission finds:

- (1) On February 23, 1995, the Commission issued a Finding and Order which established costs for EFC management/performance (m/p) audits which were to be conducted by consultants. Finding No. (20) of the Finding and Order stated, in part, that the audit costs enumerated in the Finding and Order included all associated expenses and the cost associated with presenting expert testimony before the Commission.
- (2) It was the Commission's intent, with this series of m/p audits, to not include the cost of providing testimony as part of the overall audit cost. Therefore, the Finding and Order should have stated the following:

The total cost of each individual m/p audit shall not exceed the amount enumerated on Attachment 2. This cost does not include the cost of providing expert testimony before the Commission, if required. The cost of providing expert testimony shall be billed separately, at the actual cost of time, materials and expenses, not to exceed \$5,000, unless otherwise approved by the Commission.


It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the February 23, 1995, Finding and Order in the instant cases be amended, nunc pro tunc, as stated in Finding No. (2) of this entry, for the purpose of correcting the treatment of the m/p audit costs related to providing expert testimony before the Commission. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Finding and Order be served upon the companies and upon all other parties of record to these proceedings.


