ENTRY

The attorney examiner, pursuant to the authority granted by Rule 4901-1-14, Ohio Administrative Code, finds:

- (1) By entry dated November 29, 1995, the settlement conference in this matter was scheduled on January 11, 1995.
- (2) In a telephone conversation occurring on December 13, 1995, counsel for one of the respondents, GTE, informed the attorney examiner that he would be unable to attend the January 11, 1996 settlement conference and asked to have it rescheduled.
- (3) By agreement of the parties, the settlement conference should be rescheduled to occur on January 29, 1996 at 1:30 p.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.

- (4) In addition, the above-referenced November 29, 1995 entry incorrectly indicated that the deadline for requesting intervention by any entity was December 6, 1995. The correct intervention date should be 15 days prior to the hearing date. If a hearing does become necessary in this case, the deadline for intervention will be set in the entry scheduling the hearing date.


It is, therefore,
