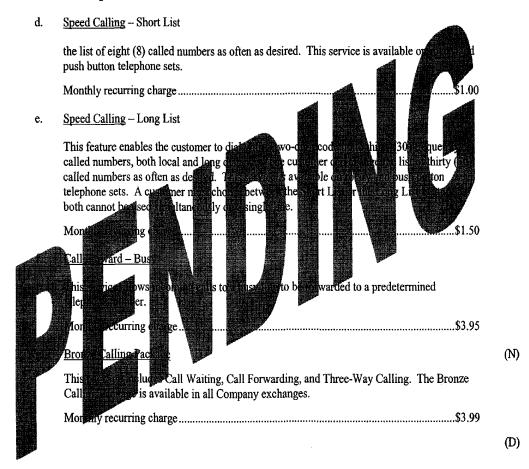

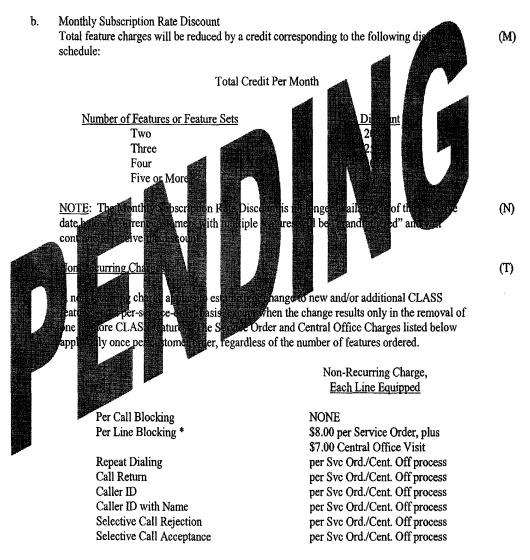

EXHIBIT C

The Applicant, The Benton Ridge Telephone Company, hereby proposes to increase its service charge for checks returned due to insufficient funds. By doing so, the Applicant's objective is to encourage full and proper payment of customer invoices. The increased charge is intended to recover both the actual charge imposed by the banks for returned checks, as well as the labor expenses associated with the handling of such checks. By reducing the amount of time its customer service representatives spend handling returned checks, the Applicant can devote more resources to providing the highest levels of service to all of its customers.

Additionally, the Applicant proposes to add a non-recurring charge applicable to Custom Calling Services. Such non-recurring charge will be identical to that approved for CLASS features and equals the total of the Company's Service Order and Central Office charges, as set forth in Section 1 of the Applicant's tariff.

Lastly, the Applicant is correcting the Service Order and Central Office charges that appear as Non-Recurring Charges on Sheet 8 of Section 2B. The referenced rates do not correctly correspond to the long-established Service Order and Central Office charges set forth on Sheet No. 3 of Section 1.
