The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) A hearing was convened in this matter on August 16, 2005. At the hearing, Commission staff stated that the parties had worked out a settlement agreement and that staff expected to execute the agreement in the near future. Staff, however, reserved the right to reschedule the hearing if settlement negotiations were not successful. Thereafter, the hearing concluded pending the submission of a settlement agreement.
- (2) On December 5, 2005, staff filed a letter requesting that the hearing date for the case be rescheduled. In support of its request, staff stated that settlement negotiations have broken down.
- (3) Staff's request should be granted. The hearing in this matter should be rescheduled on January 25, 2006, at 10:00 a.m., in hearing room 11-G, in the offices of the Commission, 180 E. Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.


It is, therefore,


