ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 19 and 27, 1996, Commission staff served notices of preliminary determination upon Kaye Trucking and Leasing Company, Inc. (Kaye) in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging violations of the Commission's Transportation Safety Rules.
- (2) On April 10, 1996, Kaye filed requests for administrative hearings in the above-captioned cases in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) By entry of April 26, 1996, these cases were consolidated and scheduled for prehearing conference on May 16, 1996. The prehearing conference was continued to and held on June 20, 1996.
- (4) On August 30, 1996, a letter was docketed by the assistant attorney general assigned to these cases. The letter stated that the combined full payment of the civil forfeitures, or \$300, in Case No. 96-361-TR-CVF and Case No. 96-546-TR-CVF, recommended by staff in these cases has been received by the Commission. Further, the assistant attorney general requests that these cases be dismissed.
- (5) With payments of the civil forfeitures, these cases may be dismissed and closed as a matter of record.


It is, therefore,






