RELEASE AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Release and Settlement Agreement is entered into between the Parties in settlement of Case No. 00-1164-EL-CSS, filed before the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio and the allegations contained therein. The Parties agree that the Complainant, Mr. Wellman, believes that he was overcharged for electricity on his account at his residence and that such overcharge was traced to loose connections inside his meter box.

American Electric Power Company/Columbus Southern Power Company (AEP) has agreed to provide Mr. Wellman with a credit of \$200.00 to his electric account, in addition to a \$75.00 credit previously provided, to settle this matter. Although this matter has been settled, a permanent record of these proceeding, including this settlement, shall be maintained at the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

In consideration of the credits provided by AEP, Mr. Wellman, hereby agrees to indemnify, release and forever discharge American Electric Power Company, Columbus Southern Power Company and their subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, agents and assigns (Indemnitees) from and against all liability of any nature arising out of electric service and billing problems experienced or alleged to have been experienced at 5110 Parkline Drive prior to this date, specifically including but not limited to those matters complained of the above referenced case.

It is further agreed and understood that the credit and other matters agreed to by the Indemnitees shall in no way be construed as an admission of liability.
