

information in its application, wherein TCG identifies its well-known investors, "the resources of any one of which, standing alone, would be a sufficient financial qualification." TCG Application at ¶¶ 1, 6. Accordingly, TCG certainly would not object if the Commission were to determine that the confidential financial viability information already provided is adequate and that the financial information provided herewith is no longer needed. Such a determination, of course, would not affect the status of the attached financial information as confidential.

For the reasons explained below, TCG is requesting that certain limited information--the supplemental financial viability information--be treated by the Commission on a basis designed to protect confidentiality. TCG presently is not aware that any information other than the financial viability information requested by the Commission is in need of such protection; however, TCG reserves the right to file further motions for such protection should the need arise.

II. TCG'S REQUEST

TCG requests that the Commission issue an order designating as confidential all the dollar values appearing in the attached three-page document containing TCG's projected profit and loss statement, cash flow statement and balance sheet ("Financial Information"). (Attachment) The Financial Information is being provided in response to the Attorney Examiner's request that TCG file "financial viability" information, as stated. Entry at ¶ 2(b) (May 23, 1996).

Specifically, TCG requests that the protective order include a provision to the following effect:
