ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On October 28, 2002, the Commission issued a certificate as a competitive retail electric service (CRES) provider (Certificate No. 00-005) to Strategic Energy, LLC (Strategic) to provide aggregation and power marketer services within Ohio. The expiration date for Certificate 00-005 is October 27, 2004.
- (2) On October 22, 2004, Strategic filed a motion for an extension of the certificate expiration date. Strategic notes that it filed its application to renew its CRES certification on October 1, 2004; however, it states that its renewal application was not filed more than 30 days prior to the expiration date contained on its certificate, as required by Rule 4901:1-27-09(A), Ohio Administrative Code. As a result, Strategic requests that the Commission grant an extension of the expiration date of its certificate until November 1, 2004, or until the Commission rules upon its renewal application.
- (3) The examiner believes that an extension of the expiration date until November 1, 2004, is warranted so that CRES certification of this company does not lapse and so that Strategic's customers will not be adversely affected while this renewal application is under consideration.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Strategic's motion for an extension of the certificate expiration date be granted. It is, further

ORDERED, That the October 27, 2004 expiration date be extended to November 1, 2004. It is, further,

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ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


