ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On December 21, 2000, the Dayton Power and Light Company (hereinafter DP&L) filed an application for waiver from Rule 4901:1-10-05(G), Ohio Administrative Code (hereinafter O.A.C.), which provides that "[e]ach meter owner shall identify each customer meter, which it owns, operates, or maintains, by company name and serial or assigned meter numbers and/or letters, placed in a conspicuous position on the meter."
- (2) DP&L asserts that, to date, it has identified or labeled ten percent of its approximately 500,000 meters. DP&L further states that it has instituted a process whereby DP&L employees are placing labels on the meters.
- (3) DP&L requests a waiver from Rule 4901:1-10-05(G), O.A.C., until December 31, 2001.
- (4) The Commission finds this request to be reasonable. Therefore, we grant DP&L's requested waiver from Rule 4901:1-10-05(G), O.A.C., until December 31, 2001.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That DP&L is granted a waiver from Rule 4901:1-10-05(G), O.A.C., until December 31, 2001. It is, further,

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
ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.




