ENTRY

The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) On August 22, 2002, the Commission approved in this proceeding the application and proposed tariffs of Vectren Energy Delivery of Ohio, Inc. (VEDO) for the institution of a gas choice program in its service territory. Joining in the stipulation approved as part of this process was a group of stakeholders who were participants in the Gas Choice Program Working Group (GCP Working Group), organized by VEDO. The GCP Working Group met over a series of months beginning on March 20, 2002 to provide input of stakeholders in the ultimate development of the gas choice plan. Parties to the stipulation include VEDO and its parent corporation (Vectren Corporation), its affiliated supplier (Vectren Retail, LLC, dba Vectren Source), PUCO Staff, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, AMPO, Inc., Interstate Gas Supply, Inc., Ohio Partners for Affordable Energy, Energy Cooperative of Ohio, Volunteer Energy Services, and the Ohio Farm Bureau.
- (2) In its Order, the Commission directed VEDO to file a report of any changes in the Transportation Program Cost Rider, including costs incurred and revenue received, no later than one year after the inception date of the rider, and annually thereafter. On December 5, 2003, VEDO filed the first such report.
- (3) On February 23, 2004, Staff filed its recommendations with respect to the VEDO report.
- (4) On February 23, 2004, objections to the staff report were filed by Office of Consumers Counsel (OCC).
- (5) On June 9, 2004, the attorney examiner scheduled a conference of the parties for June 30, 2004. The purpose of the conference

was to discuss the report, the staff recommendations and the OCC objections.


- (6) On June 25, 2004, counsel for staff filed a letter in this docket advising that staff, OCC and VEDO have agreed that the issues raised in this proceeding should be considered as part of VEDO's recently filed rate case, 04-511-GA-AIR. The staff further requests that the scheduled conference be cancelled.
- (7) The attorney examiner finds the request should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the conference previously scheduled in this matter for June 30, 2004 is cancelled. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all interested parties of record in this case.
