Attached is Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company's (CBT's) Application requesting an order for authorization to revise its General Exchange Tariff, PUCO No. 8, Section 22. In this filing, CBT proposes to reduce the monthly rates for Touch-Tone Calling Service in accordance with its Alternative Regulation Plan and associated Stipulation Agreement in Case No. 93-432-TP-ALT.

Touch-Tone calling service is an adjunct to exchange service and provides for the origination of calls using instruments equipped for tone-type address signaling and special central office facilities. Where the customer has the capability to originate exchange type calls using any type of instrument equipped for tone-type address signaling, the rates and charges shown in this section apply.

Customer Notification

Applicant proposes to revise its General Exchange Tariff, PUCO No. 8, Section 22. CBT proposes to reduce the monthly rates for Touch-Tone Calling Service in accordance with its Alternative Regulation Plan and its associated Stipulation Agreement in Case No. 93-432-TP-ALT. The proposed decrease in rates will result in an annual revenue reduction exceeding \$900,000.

Customers will be notified of this change through a bill message which will be included on the bills following the implementation of the new reduced rates. Notification to all customers will be completed within approximately 45 days of the rate change.
