The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) On December 28, 2001, Arm-Food, Inc. (Complainant), filed a complaint against FirstEnergy Corporation a/k/a/ CEI (FirstEnergy, Respondent) alleging that Respondent unlawfully billed Complainant for usage supplied to a previous customer of FirstEnergy at the same address.
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 4901-9-01, O.A.C., the Secretary of the Commission served a copy of the complaint on Respondent and directed Respondent to file an answer to the complaint, along with any responsive motion, with the Commission and serve a copy of the answer and any motion upon the Complainant.
- (3) This matter should be set for a settlement conference to be held on February 27, 2002, at 10:00 a.m., in Hearing Room 11-D at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio. The purpose of the settlement conference is to determine whether this matter can be informally resolved. The parties should bring with them all documents relevant to this matter. If it is determined that this matter cannot be resolved, the mediator and the parties should narrow the issues and identify the disputed facts for the hearing.


It is, therefore,


