ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Ohio Power Company (Ohio Power) and Hancock-Wood Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Hancock-Wood) are electric suppliers as defined in Section 4933.81, Revised Code.
- (2) Certification by the Commission of the territories of Ohio Power and Hancock-Wood was approved by Entries September 28, 1983 and May 6, 1981 in Case No. 78-1311-EL-ORD.
- (3) Ohio Power and Hancock-Wood have jointly petitioned the Commission to reallocate their service territories in Allen Township, Hancock County, Ohio. Specifically, they request the following relocation:

On quadrangle map E10-North Baltimore, relocate the existing boundary line at the south east corner of section 7 beginning at a point 300 feet south from the center line of the intersection of State Route (S.R.) 613 and Township Road 229; thence 300 feet west along the existing boundary line; thence 400 feet south along the existing boundary line to the property line of community park and youth sports center complex; thence 980 feet west along the property line to the center line of S.R. 613; thence 535 feet south along the property line; thence 560 feet east along the property line to where it meets the existing boundary line.

- (4) In support of their request, the petitioners state that an Ohio Power customer currently straddles the existing territorial boundary line between Ohio Power and Hancock-Wood and the customer is being served from Ohio Power's Single-Phase facilities. The customer now desires three-phase service but due to the distance from Ohio Power's facilities, it is not practical for Ohio Power to provide three-phase service to the customer.

Hancock-Wood has three-phase facilities located adjacent to the complex and Hancock-Wood is willing and able to provide service to this customer.

- (5) Section 4933.83 (E), Revised Code, provides in pertinent part:

Notwithstanding the effectuation of certified territories established by or pursuant to Sections 4933.81 to 4933.90 of the Revised Code, and the exclusive right of electric suppliers to serve within such territory, and notwithstanding any other provisions of such sections establishing rights of electric suppliers to furnish electric service, any two or more electric suppliers may jointly petition the Commission for the reallocation of their own territories and electric load centers among them and designating which portions of such territories and electric load centers are to be served by each of the electric suppliers.

- (6) The Staff has reviewed this petition and recommends approval of the boundary line relocation described in Finding (3).
- (7) No exception to the change described in Finding (3) has been brought to the Commission's attention.
- (8) The Commission finds that granting the requested relief will promote the purposes of Sections 4933.81 to 4933.90, Revised Code, and will further promote the provision of adequate service to all territories and electric load centers affected by the relocation. Accordingly, the Commission shall order the appropriate modification of the territorial boundary of Ohio Power and Hancock-Wood.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request of Ohio Power and Hancock-Wood to relocate their territory boundary is granted. It is, further,


ORDERED, That the change on quadrangle map E10-North Baltimore, described in Finding (3), be approved to show the boundary line change. It is, further,






